## New International Project

March - June 15 2023

Orphan Assistance Fund has a new international project with Kids Alive International! With the Hall Mead School Project, OAF aims to provide over 100,000 meals for an orphanage school in Kenya. The fundraiser goal is **\$6,000** and the fundraiser will end on **June 15**.

The money goes toward giving three meals a day to impoverished Kenyan children working in quarries. At Hall Mead School, these kids gain education with kind staff. There's free uniforms, holistic care, school supplies, family support, community outreach and specialist trauma care. Due to the crops Hall Mead School owns, each meal only costs about six cents. If OAF meets the fundraiser goal, more than 100,000 meals will go to the community in Kenya.
